Please be sure to log all offenses in student's behavior folder. Include conversations with parents on phone log and print out email correspondences, if any. If referral is written, and immediate action is needed, please contact the Dean right away.

Counselor Level

The student will have an opportunity to problem- solve with the counselor. Prior to consequences, the counselor will offer a restorative/ solution- based approach to support the student. The counselor is a proactive resource to help the student to work through issues they may be experiencing. A referral form is located on the T- Drive.

Dean Level

After Teacher and Counselor has addressed the same offense, or in the event of Major Classroom Disruptions, the Dean will intervene. Focus: Restorative Justice.

Administration Level

If a student is exhibiting habitual, repeat behaviors, this will result in further discipline.

IMMEDIATE ACTION PROCEDURES

If any student's behavior/actions fall into the categories indicated below:

1. Contact the office or Dean and ask for an adult/ help to come and escort the student out of the classroom.
2. The student will face administrative action.
